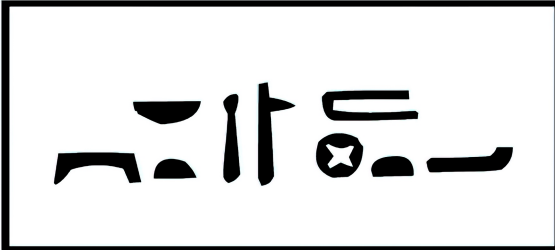
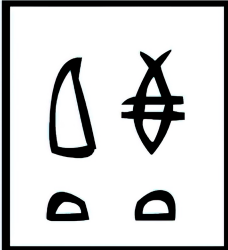

- 22 I am the Snake that with Knowledge & Delight

and strange drugs whereof I will tell my
prophet, & be drunk thereof! They shall not
harm ye at all. It is a lie, this folly
against self. The response of innocence
is a lie. Be strong, O man, lust, enjoy
all things of sense and repture: fear not
that any God shall deny thee for this.
- 23 I am alone: there is no God where I am.
- 24 Behold! there be grave mysteries; for there
are also of my friends who be hermits. Now

Think not to find them in the forest or on the
mountain; but in beds of purple, caressed by
magnificent hosts of women with large limbs,
and fire and light in their eye, and masses
of flaming hair about them; there shall ye
find them. Ye shall see them at rule, at

- 40 A feast for the Supreme Ritual, and a feast for the E-gnosis of the Gods.
- 41 A feast for fire and a feast for water; a feast for life and a greater feast for death.

42 A feast every day in your hearts in the

43 A feast every night unto Wast, and the
pleasure of uttermost delight.

44 Aye! feast! rejoice! there is no dread
hereafter. There is the dissolution, and

45 There is health for the dregs.

46 Dost Thou fail? Art Thou sorry? Is fear
in Thine heart?

47 Where I am these are not.

- 48 Pity not the fallen! I never knew them.
I am not for them. I console not. I hate
the unsoled & the unsole.
- 49 I am unyoke & conqueror. I am not of the
Slaves, that Jewish. Be they damned &
dead! Amen. [This is of the 4: there is
a fifth who is invisible & therein am I
as a babe in an egg.]
- 50 Blue am I and gold in the light of my
blade: but the red gleam is in my eyes
& my sprangles are purple & green.
51. Purple beyond purple: it is the light in the

than eyesight.

52 There is a veil: that veil is black. It is the veil of the modest woman; it is the veil of sorrow, & the pall of death: this is none of me. Fear thou that lying spectre of the centuries: wilt not you vices in virtuous words: these vices are my service; ye do well, & I will reward you here and hereafter.

53 Fear not, O prophet, when these words are said, thou shalt not be sorry. Thou art unambiguously my chosen; and blessed art

The eyes that thou shalt look upon with
gladness. But I will hide thee in a
mask of sorrow: they that see thee shall
fear thou art fallen: but I lift thee up.

54 Nor shall they who cry aloud their folly
that thou meanest nought avail; thou

as it was. Yet there are washed men my
 servants: it may be that gonderbeggan is
 a King. A King may choose his garment as
 he will: there is no certain test: but a
 beggar cannot hide his poverty.

- 59 Beware therefore! Love all, lest perdition is a
 King uncerled! Say you so? Fool! If he
 be a King, thou canst not hunt him.
- 60 Therefore strike hard & low and to hell
 with them, master!
- 61 There is a light before thine eyes & prophesied
 a light undesired, most desirable.

- 62 I am uplifted in thine herit and the kisses
of the stars rain hard upon thy body.
- 63 Thou art exhaust in the voluptuous fullness
of the aspiration: the aspiration is sweeter
than death, more rapid and lengthful than
a caress of Hell's own worm.
- 64 O L! Thou art overcome: we are upon thee,
our delight is all over thee: hail! hail!

- 65 I am the Master: from all the Holy Chosen the

- 69 Ah! Ah! What do I feel? / the word

- 70 There is help & hope in other spells. Wisdom
says: be strong! Then cannot thou have more
joy. Be not animal; refine thy raptures!
If thou drink, drink by the right and strict
rules of art: if thou love, succeed by
delicacy and if thou do any let joy on, let
there be subtlety therein!
- 71 But succeed! exceed!
- 72 Strive ever to more! and if thou art true

mine - and doubt if not, an if thou art
ever joyous! - death is the crown of all

73 A h! Ha! Death! Death! Thou shalt long for
death. Death is forbidden, O man, unto thee.

74 The length of thy longing shall be the strength
of its glory. He that lives long & denies

 - 2 There is dwi in lither homeward; there is a word not known. Spelling is defunct; all is not aught. Beware! Hold! Raise the spell of Ra-Hoor-Vihint.
 - 3 Now let it be just understood that I am a god of War and of Vengeance. I shall deal hardly with them.
 - 4 Choose ye an island!
 - 5 Fortify it!
 - 6 Dug it about with machinery of war!
 - 7 I will give you a war-ship.
 - 8 With it ye shall smite the peoples and

none shall stand before you.

- 9 Lark! Withdraw! Upon them! This is the Law of the Battle of conquest: thus shall my worship be about my secret house
- 10 Get the steli of revealing itself; set it in my secret temple - and that temple is already aight disposed - & it shall be your Kiblah for ever. It shall not fade, but miraculous colom shall come back to it day after day. Do it in locked glass for a proof to the world.
- 11 This shall be your only proof. I forbid argument. Conquer! That is enough. I will make eas

to you the abstraction from the ill-ordained
house in the Victorious City. Thou shalt
thyself convey it with worship, & prophet;
though thou livest it not. Thou shalt have

22. The other images group around me to support me: let all be worshipped, for they shall cluster to exalt me. I am the visible object of worship; the others are secret; for the Beast & the Bride are they: and for the winners of the Ordeal &c. What is this? Thou shalt know
- 23 For perfume mixe meel & honey & thick leavings of red wine: then oil of Abramelin and olive oil, and afterward soften & smooth down with rich fresh blood!
- 24 The best blood is of the moon, monthly: then the fresh blood of a child, or dropping from the

- 28 Also ye shall be strong in war.

- 29 Moreover, be they long kept, it is better; for

in silver or gold.

shall pour his gold upon thee.
- 32 From gold forge steel.
- 33 Be ready to fly or to smite
- 34 But your holy place shall be untouched
throughout the centuries: Though with fire and
Sword it be burnt down & shattered, yet
an inner temple there standeth and

utterly. Swift as a trodden serpent thou.

- and strike! Be thou yet deadlier than he!
- 42 Drag down their souls to awful torment: laugh at their fear: spit upon them!
- 43 Let the Scarlet Woman beware! If pity and compassion and tenderness visit her heart if she leave my work to toy with old sweet nesses then shall my vengeance be known. I will slay me her child: I will alienate her heart: I will cast her out from men: as a shrinking and despised ~~whore~~ shall she crawl through dusk wet streets, and die cold and an-hungry.

44. But let her raise herself in pride. Let her follow me in my way. Let her work the work of wickedness! Let her kill her heart! Let her be loud and adulterous; let her be covered with jewels, and rich garments, and let her be shameless before all men!

45 Then will I lift her to pinnacles of power: then will I breed from her a child my lotri than all the kings of the earth. I will fill her with joy: with my face shall she see & strike at the worship of Me. she shall achieve Hadit.

46. I am the warrior Lord of the Forties: the
 Egyptians come before me, & are abased
 I will bring you to victory & joy: I will be
 at your arms in battle & ye shall
 delight to slay. Success is your proof;
 Courage is your armour; go on, go on, in
 my strength & ye shall turn not back for
 any.

47 This book shall be translated into all
 tongues: but always with the original in
 the writing of the Beast; for in the

chance shape of the letters and their
 position to me another: in these mysteries
 that no Beast shall divine. Let him
 not seek to try: but me cometh after
 him, whence I say not, who shall
 discover the key of it all. Then
 this line drawn is a key: then this
 circle squared \oplus in its failure is a
 key also. And Abrahamaba. It shall
 be his child & that strangely. Let him not
 seek after this; for thereby alone can he
 fall from it.

48 Now this mystery of the letters is done, and
I want to go on to the higher plane.

49 I am in a secret fourfold word, the blasphemy against
all gods of men.

50 Curse them! Curse them! Curse them!

51 With my Hawk's beak I peck at the eyes of
Jesus as he hangs upon the cross

52 I flap my wings in the face of Mohammed &
blind him

53 With my claws I tear out the flesh of the
Indian and the Buddhist - Mongol and
Din.

54 Bahlasti! Ompheda! Spit on you

crapulous creeds.

- 55 Let Mary inviolate be torn upon wheels:
for her sake let all chaste women be
utterly despised among you.
- 56 Also for beauty's sake and love's.
- 57 Despise all cowards; professional soldiers
who dare not fight, but play: all fools despise
- 58 But the keen and the proud, the royal and
the lofty: ye are brothers!
- 59 As brothers fight ye.
- 60 There is no law beyond Do what thou wilt.
- 61 There is an end of the word of the God

enthroned in Ras' seat, by taking the guides
of the soul.

62 To be do ye reverence; come come ye
through tribulation of ordeal, which is
bless.

63 The fool readeth the Book of the Law, and
its comment & he understandeth it not.

64 Let him come through the first ordeal &
it will be to him as silver

65 through the second gold

66 through the third, stores of precious water.

67 through the fourth, ultimate sparks of the
infinite fire.

68 Yet to all it shall seem beautiful. Its
 enemies who say not so, are mere liars.

69 There is success

70 I am the Bush-Bodied Lord of Silence
 & of Strength; my hands, I bound the
 light-blue sky.

71 Hail! ye twin warriors about the pillars of
 the world! for your pine is my right hand

72 I am the Lord of the Double Hand of Power
 the wand of the ^{force of Coph} ~~Coph~~ ^{Phia} ~~Phia~~ - I but my
 left hand is empty, for I have unrolled

An Universe & world remains.

73 Paste the sheets from right to left and
from top to bottom: then behold!

74 There is a splendour in my name hidden
and glorious, as the sun of midday, but is
and the son
